The Implementation of INTEGR8 Training

Between May and November 2018, after the development of the educational resources and tools, the INTEGR8 partnership organised a set of events that corresponded to the implementation phase of the project:

- The delivery of the “Train the Trainer Courseware”.
- The delivery of the “Migrant Integration Expert” Course.
- The establishment of Social Networks.
- The realisation of integration workshops and seminars to engage stakeholders.

These activities occurred in seven different countries (Ireland, Austria, Cyprus, Italy, Portugal, England and Romania) involving up to a 1000 participants between professionals, migrant women and hosting country natives
